Location: a major port city in eastern Shandong Province. On the coast of the Yellow Sea, Qingdao lies on the west coast of Pacific Ocean and at the southern tip of Shandong Peninsula of north China and faces Korea and Japan across the sea in the east.

Population: 8.964 million (2014) **Area:** 11,282 square kilometers

Administrative Divisions: 6 districts and 4 county-level cities

6 Key Industries: Logistics, shipbuilding and maritime engineering, home appliances and electronics, automobiles and railway engines, petrochemicals, and machinery and equipment

10 Emerging Industries: new materials, environmental protection, aviation economics, tourism equipment, maritime biological medicine manufacturing industry, industrial robots, maritime equipment, seawater desalination industry, maritime energy and 3D printing technology.

Qingdao is one of China's first coastal open cities, an important international trading port as well as a maritime transport hub in China. It is one of China's top five ports for foreign trade. The Port of Qingdao has built trade relationship with more than 700 ports worldwide. In 2013, the port handled 455 million tons of cargo and 15.52 million TEUs. Its total throughput ranked the 7th in the world and its throughput of crude oil ranked the 1st in China.

Chengdu: The World's Fastest-Growing City









Population (2014): Sub-provincial city14,047,625. Urban 7,415,590,

GDP (2014): USD163.7 billion (RMB 1006 billion) - The highest in Western China

The city is served by **Chengdu Shuangliu International Airport** the first in Western China. It will be the 3rd city with 2 international airports in China.

Key Industries: Pharmaceuticals, Food Processing, Automotive, Aerospace, Metallurgy, Finance, ICT, Retail, Petrochemical, Tourism

Top 5 reasons to do business in Chengdu:

- 1. Chengdu is China's western centre of logistics, commerce, finance, science and technology.
- The total volume of imports and exports of the Chengdu Hi-tech Industrial Development Zone (CHDT) ranked 3rd in the country and first in central and western China. The Chengdu Tianfu Software Park, based in CHDT, is Asia's largest specialized business IT Park and one of China's 10 national software industry bases.
- 3. The city has a long history of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). Over 6,000 medical equipment and pharmaceutical companies are registered here.
- 4. There are over 265 Fortune 500 companies with business in Chengdu. The 12th Fortune Global Forum was held in Chengdu in June 2013.
- 5. Chengdu has an excellent telecommunications infrastructure.
- 6. Ranked 5th of Innovation and Entrepreneurial Environment in China and 1st in Mid & West China.

By the reputation of Western Silicon Valley, it has been listed into Top 100 Best Commercial Cities in the Chinese mainland by the Forbes.

Location: northwest of Sichuan Province, 90 kilometers away from the capital city Chengdu

Population: 5.45 million

Area: 20,249 square kilometers

Administrative Divisions: 1 county-level city, 6 counties and 2 urban districts

GDP (2014):EUR22.2 Billion (RMB158 Billion) **Import & Export(2014):** USD2.9 Billion

Mianyang is the second largest city in Sichuan province. It is China's sole city of science and technology. It is a central city in the northwest of Chengdu-Chongqing Economic Zone (China's regional development plan). Mianyang is a key research and manufacturing center for the defense and electronics industries in China. Mianyang enjoys the reputation as the "Silicon Valley in Western China" and "Smart City". Mianyang was selected by the State Council among the first group of national pilot cities for promoting the integration of finance and technologies as well as among the first group of national pilot cities to adopt a single data cable servicing Internet, telephone and television.

Mianyang is of rich scientific and technological resources, including 18 national scientific institutes, 26 academicians from Chinese Academy of Sciences and Chinese Academy of Engineering, and 202000 professional and technical personnel; the built innovation center of city of science and technology; industrial technology research institute and achievement transformation platform. The talent resources of science and technology and innovation capability are ranking the front place among the same kind of cities in China. And the numbers of patent application and patent granted are in the 5th place. For the 17 important scientifically special projects implemented by the nation, 3 projects are owned by Mianyang.

The **EU-China Business and Technology Cooperation Fair** has been held for 9 editions, with an overall attendance of over 2,400 European enterprises, international organizations, governmental authorities, universities and research institutions as well as more than 4,400 Chinese counterparts. A total of 22,291 B2B matchmaking meetings have been held and 1,465 successful cooperation agreements between European and Chinese delegates were reached so far.

Today, the **EU-China Business and Technology Cooperation Fair** has become a significant event for development of China relations for most of the EU member states. Attended by wide representations of EU enterprises, as well as high-level officials, including *President, Minister, Ambassador, Consul-General and Chairman of Chamber of Commerce*, etc. it represents the largest platform for investment, trade and technological cooperation between European Union and China with successful promotion of local governmental cooperation, like launching direct flights, twin city relations, co-building of schools, establishment of consulates, etc.
